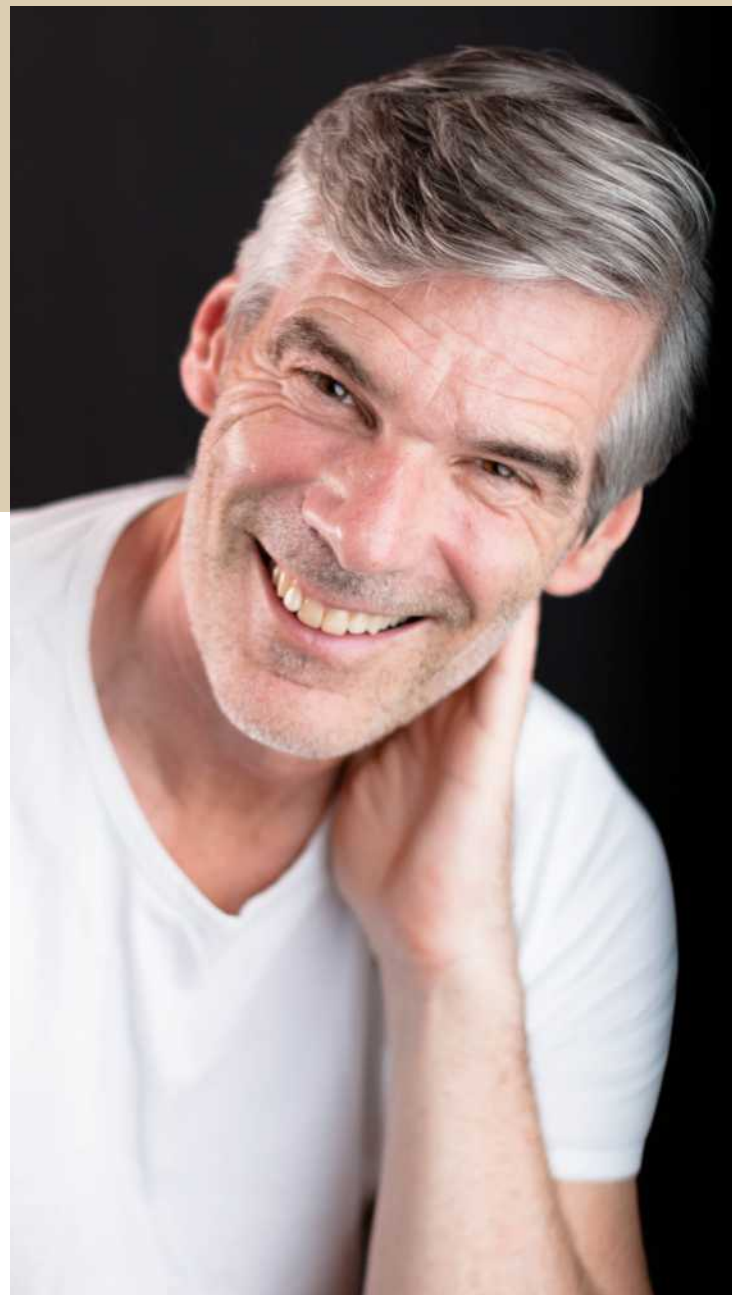


# Roberta Setzu

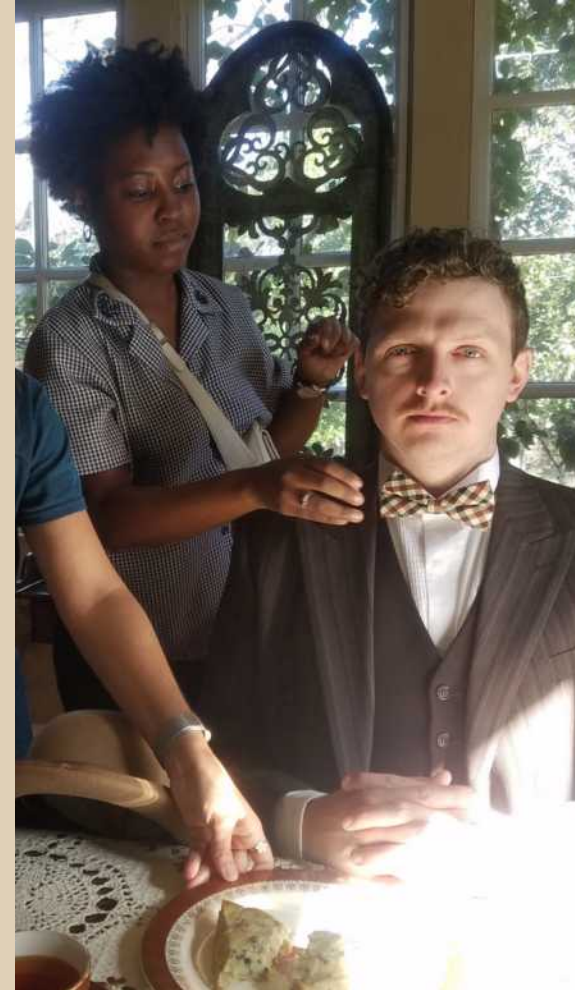
